TERM 3 CLUBS (APRIL-JULY)

Our after school clubs are held at different venues in Kensington and Chelsea. All clubs cost £10/session for the term or £13 to drop in. For an additional £2/session, we collect Lycee Francais SK children from the school gates at 3:35pm and travel to the venue together. Children from other schools in the area are welcome to attend from 4-5pm.



Monday

Wild Drama (7-11 years) at Princes Gardens SW7

Here children are given the freedom to explore their theatrical sides through music, drama, and dance - all in a picturesque outdoor setting. Led by our drama teacher Kinvara. (10 sessions).

Culture Vultures Museums Club (7-11 years) SW7

Take full advantage of some of the best museums in world sitting on our doorstep. The children will alternate between the Natural History Museum, The Victoria and Albert Museum, and the Science Museum, where they will each week learn about a different treasure and then sketch, draw, or paint it. Limited to 8 spaces. (10 sessions).

Tuesdays

English Support (5-11 years) at Goat Chelsea, 333 Fulham Road SW10

Here's an opportunity for beginner and intermediate English speakers to get that extra bit of practice that will lead to a breakthrough. Build confidence in a fun and relaxed environment where the emphasis is on learning

◆ new vocabulary and improving your speaking through games, music and drama. (11 sessions).

Art Club (5-11 years) at Goat Chelsea, 333 Fulham Road SW10

At this club we give children the tools and guidance to create something special each week, whether it be a painting, sculpture, collage, or haberdashery. Parents welcome to stay for coffee. (11 sessions).
